For electronic equipment racks (e.g., 19 or 23 inches wide), the term 1U is used to define one rack unit of height. 3U height would be $3 \times 1.75" = 5.25$ -inches. It should be noted that the 1U, ...

inches tall, and so on. The "U" standard makes it easy to calculate how many pieces ...
