Rung Spacing: Single conductor over 4/0 and MC cables should be used with 12" or 18" rung spacing. Smaller diameter cables require 6" or 9" rung spacing. Trough, solid or ventilated type tray offer ...

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392.30 (A). Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while ...

As per the NEC, the maximum allowable rung spacing is 9 inches (230 mm) when cable tray carries single-conductor cables of 1/0 to 4/0 AWG (American Wire Gauge) (Appendix I).

Powder coated tray requires the removal of the coating in the clamping area in order to create a bond. Cable tray should be bonded to the building or facility grounding system every 50" - 60".
