If the box opening is less than 8 inches in any direction, each wire must stick out at least 3 inches from the box opening. This extra length helps you make safe and easy connections.

Junction boxes must remain accessible after installation without tearing into the building's structure. NEC Section 314.29 requires that you be able to reach the wiring inside by simply ...
