

# What s the best way to bundle network cabinet cables

The goal of forward cable management is to create bundles of horizontal twisted pair cables from the entry point of the server room (or network area) to the patch panel cabinets.

Cable routing is an important issue when designing server cabinets. The level of wire arranging influences the performance of the entire system and hardware durability.

The cables emerge from the comb in a smooth, organized bundle. Wrap the combed bundle with Velcro, tie wrap, or equivalent cable lash every 2 to 3 feet as desired to keep the cables organized and ...

Use cable management panels, Velcro straps, or cable clips to organize and bundle the cables neatly. This will not only improve the aesthetics but also help with airflow and reduce the risk of cable damage.

On the cable organizer, each 4 network cables are bound with a cable tie. Each network cable is marked with a unique label, and the other end is placed in the rack.
